

PARIS BIKE TOUR (PBT), 38 rue de Saintonge, 75003 Paris

Rental policies:

1. The rented bicycles and equipment may only be used by the designated customer.
2. The customer is obliged to take good care of the rented equipment and to protect it from damage, loss or theft. In case of loss or theft of the bicycle/s PBT will charge a total amount of 250 EUR/bike. The Police and PBT has to be informed in the case of theft or loss within 24 hours.
3. In the case of loss or damage of rented equipment or components of the bicycle, PBT will charge the missing items as the following: (Lock+keys: 50 EUR/Basket: 15 EUR/Saddle: 29 EUR/ light (front side): 5 EUR/light (back side): 12 EUR)
4. Method of payment: cash or cheque on the day of the rental for the complete rental period. The customer has to leave a cheque of 250 EUR/bike and an ID (passport, driving licence or National Identity Card for EU-Citizens) as a deposit. PBT will accept a cash deposit and the amount will be fixed when signing the rental contract. The deposit will be refunded if the rented equipment is returned in the same conditions it was procured. If the missing or broken items exceed the deposit amount, the customer must settle the balance.
5. PBT has procured itself with proper third party liability insurance coverage of the bicycle rental activity.
6. The customer is responsible for adequate personal insurance coverage for risks that may occur during the rental period. PBT is not liable for any claims for body injury or harm, accidents, damage caused to third person property or loss of personal belonging caused by weather, sickness, or any other causes whatsoever beyond the control of PBT.
7. If the customer keeps the bicycle longer than the agreed rental period he will have to inform PBT by phone within the agreed period. PBT will charge afterwards the missing rental fee.
8. The customer must respect French traffic regulations. Any ticket or fine due to incorrect use of the bicycle will be completely assumed by the customer.
9. The customer signing the rental contract must be over 18 years old. Underaged customers must be accompanied by an adult or have to present a written authorization of the parents.
10. Exclusive place of jurisdiction shall be Paris, France. This contract shall be governed by French law.
